Signs of Failing **Safety Boots**

Checking your footwear before use

At Rock Fall, your safety is our priority. Safety boots that are worn or damaged will not deliver the protection they are designed for. That's why it's vital to check your footwear daily and replace it as soon as it becomes unfit for wear.

To make this easy, we've outlined the key signs that show when your boots need replacing. Identifying these early ensures your footwear continues to provide the highest level of protection.

Upper & Sole Issues

- Cracks, deep abrasions, or split seams
- Outsole cracks over 10mm long and 3mm deep
- Separation between outsole and upper
- Cleat height reduced below 1.5mm

Other Warning Sign

- Crushed insocks or damaged lining
- Delamination or loss of bonding
- Heat damage causing melting or cleat loss
- Faulty fastenings such as broken laces or zips

Together, these issues reduce protection, slip resistance, and comfort. Always replace your footwear immediately when these signs appear.
